



KATHLEEN ANN LYONS MEMORIAL EXCELLENCE IN TEACHING AWARD

The Kathleen Ann Lyons Memorial Excellence in Teaching Award, in the amount of five hundred dollars (\$500), is to recognize and honor the work of outstanding teachers of second languages on Long Island.

TO APPLY:

- Include one letter of recommendation from the nominator.
- Include **ONE letter each from TWO of the following:** supervisor, chairperson, principal, assistant superintendent, superintendent.
- Include one letter from either a student or parent.
- A curriculum vitae of the nominee.
- Include one of the following prepared by the nominee and submitted by the nominator: a videotaped lesson, sample lesson plans with activities, curriculum material the nominee has developed (These materials may be made available for future LILT publications and/or LILT functions.), or one student portfolio.

REQUIREMENTS:

- The nominator must be a current LILT member for the last two consecutive years.
- The nominee must have taught for at least five (5) years.

Current members of LILT's Executive Board are not eligible for this award.

Members of the LILT Excellence in Teaching Award Selection Committee may NOT nominate a candidate.
