CATEGORIES: Category A: Grades 4-6, Category B: Grades 7-9, Category C: Grades 10-12

RULES:

1. Each entry must bear **ONLY ONE** student's name.
2. All posters must be 18" x 24" and prepared on **oak tag** on any color. The 18" side must be on top of the poster. **NO** other size, including 3-D or other material will be accepted.
3. **NO** computer graphics or computer-generated designs will be accepted.
4. Artistic media: water colors, felt tips, colored pencils, or collages. **NO** other media will be accepted.
5. The poster **must** include the theme; foreign language(s) may be used elsewhere on the poster. Entries containing spelling or grammatical errors will be **disqualified**.
6. All work must be original; **NO** copyrighted figures, slogans, etc. will be allowed.
7. **The student's name, school name, school address, grade of the artist and the name of the student's teacher must be written on the back of the poster. NO IDENTIFICATION MAY APPEAR ON THE FRONT.**
8. A maximum of **5** posters per category, per school will be accepted.
9. The 5 posters **MUST BE** flat and neatly wrapped separately according to **CATEGORY**. Please affix a copy of the **ENTRY SUBMISSION FORM** to the **outside** of the package and include a duplicate on the **inside** of the package.
10. ***Only posters that meet the above rules will be eligible for judging. All others will be disqualified.***
11. All memberships must be current/paid-up for the calendar year in which the contest is held.
12. **PLEASE VERIFY YOUR MEMBERSHIP AND THE ABOVE RULES SO YOUR STUDENTS WILL NOT BE DISQUALIFIED.**
