ELIGIBILITY: All Nassau and Suffolk County students of languages whose teachers are PAID-UP MEMBERS of *one* of the Nassau or Suffolk sponsoring organizations

PRIZES: First Place, Second Place, Third Place and Honorable Mention(s)

CATEGORIES: Category A: Grades 4-6
Category B: Grades 7-9
Category C: Grades 10-12

RULES:

1. Each entry must bear only one student's name.
2. All posters must be on 18" x 24" **oak tag** of any color. The 18" side must be on the top of the poster. **No** other size, including 3-D or other material will be accepted.
3. **NO** computer graphics, lettering or designs will be accepted.
4. Artistic media: felt tips, watercolors, oil or acrylic paints, pastels, colored pencils or collages. **NO** other media will be accepted.
5. The poster **MUST** include the theme in English. Foreign languages may be used elsewhere on the poster. In this case, the language(s) of **each** sponsoring organization must be represented. Entries with spelling or grammatical errors will be **disqualified**.
6. All work must be original; **NO** copyrighted figures, slogans, etc. will be allowed.
7. **The student's name, school name, school address, grade of artist and the name of the student's teacher MUST be on the BACK of the poster. NO identification may appear on the front.**
8. A maximum of **5** posters per category, per school will be accepted.
9. The 5 posters **MUST** be flat and neatly wrapped according to **CATEGORY**. Please affix a copy of the **ENTRY SUBMISSION FORM** to the **outside** of the package and include a duplicate on the **inside** of the package.
10. **Only the posters that meet the above rules will be eligible for judging. All others will be disqualified.**
11. All memberships must be current / paid up for the calendar year in which the contest is held.

PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU ARE A CURRENT MEMBER OF ONE OF THE SPONSORING ORGANIZATIONS AND EACH ENTRY ADHERES TO THE ABOVE RULES.

- _____ Grammatical or spelling errors
- _____ The languages of all four of the sponsoring organizations were not represented. This applies **only** to entries where the student chose to use words or phrases other than English.
- _____ Use of copyrighted material
- _____ Entry identification information on the back of the poster is incomplete
